## **STATEMENTS OF UNDERSTANDING**

- The IB Diploma Program (IBDP) is a two year program that takes place during a student's 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade years.
- The IBDP will be housed and run through Franklin High School.
- An IB student's entire class load will be with IB courses.
- An IB student is required to take IB exams for each course.
- An IB student must fulfill a requirement of 150 hour of Creativity, Action, and Service (CAS).
- An IB student must submit an Extended Essay of 4,000 words due in the student's senior year. This requirement often means research work during the summer months.
- Completion of a Theory of Knowledge (TOK) class and submission of a TOK essay.
- For students living outside the Franklin geographical boundaries, transportation to FHS will be the responsibility of the parent or student.
- Students may earn an LPS diploma. All students do not earn an IB diploma.
- Individual universities or colleges determine the amount of IB credits that will transfer or count as college level work.
- A fee of approximately \$1000.00 will be assessed over the two years to cover the cost of registration and IB exams.
- Student will have completed PE and Health requirement before entering the Diploma Program.
- Students will have two years of Spanish prior to entering the program.
- IB exam grades are released from the IBO in July. This means that IB students will not know if they have earned an IB diploma until after their LPS graduation.
- Students must follow IB rules and deadlines: failure to do that may result in their dismissal. Financial refunds will not be made available.
- An IB candidate must be willing to work hard and devote several hours of homework daily.
